



## A MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents/Carers,

Over the past two weeks, students from Years 3 and 5 have been busy with NAPLAN testing. This is the first year that NAPLAN has been online with all tests computerised with the exception of Year 3 Writing, which was still pen and paper. Whilst the school experienced some minor glitches with the online format, patience from both students and teachers ensured completion of the tests.

On Tuesday, 21<sup>st</sup> May, all students in Stages 2 and 3 were involved in a free singing workshop which was run by the fabulous Michelle Leonard of Moorambilla Voices. Michelle taught all of the boys and girls some basic fundamentals of the history of music, went through how to read music on their hands and taught them how to use their bodies to make the best sound possible with their voices. We were successful in having boys and girls from Stage 3 selected to be involved with the Moorambilla Voices program again in 2019, which will culminate in three grand concerts to be held at the Dubbo Regional Theatre and Convention Centre in September. Three of our students have been asked to be involved in making a special recording for Moorambilla Voices primary choir in Sydney – which means they have to learn 9 new pieces of music over the next couple of weeks! The students learnt a lot and a fun time was had by all.

The school has also been provided with a fabulous opportunity to participate in 'On the Road with Optus' on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> May. Optus are staging a series of Virtual Reality and Augmented Reality training Sessions for 60 selected students from Stage 3 and 30 students from Stage 2. These sessions align with STEM programs currently run in schools which show how technology can be used to tell a story and engage the learner. This is a fabulous opportunity and we thank OPTUS for their support of our school.

Students K - 2 will be attending the Dubbo Show Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May. Students will travel by bus and will need to wear full school uniform with hats. They will be gone from 10am – 12noon and will need to take a snack in a plastic bag.

Just a reminder that if your child is going on the Canberra Excursion, a non-refundable deposit of \$50 is due this Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May. If paying in instalments the following payments are: June 14<sup>th</sup> - \$100, July 5<sup>th</sup> - \$100 and July 26<sup>th</sup> - \$100.

Students from Years 2 - 6 will participate in the Cross Country to be held on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> May. All students from these grades will be expected to participate in the event unless otherwise informed.

A further opportunity has been offered to Dubbo West in the form of a visit from Belle Shakespeare. This visit will be for all students from Years 2 - 6 and will be held in the school hall on Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> May. Parents are welcome to join in the fun and romance of an adaptation of Shakespeare's 'Romeo and Juliet'. Past experiences have proved these performances to be an exciting and enjoyed by all.

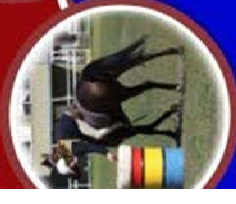
