### Is the address on your child's bus pass current?

If the address on your child's bus pass is not current you need to update these details now with Transport for NSW so that your child will get a new bus pass now and not be delayed with receiving their pass for next year. **Bus pass are not automatically updated when your child changes address.**

Make sure your child's address has been updated with their school then update their details with Transport for NSW – use the following link

<https://ssts-apply.transport.nsw.gov.au/ApplySSTS/UpdateEntitlement.html>

Choose the option "Reapply as the student is changing school, campus, home address, contact details, name or repeating a Year"

Do not use Explorer as your browser, try Chrome or Firefox, they seem to work better with Transport's site. Do not use auto fill.

When you apply you will get an application number emailed to you – keep this number, it can be used as a temporary bus pass while waiting for their bus pass to arrive, it can also be used to track the progress of your application.
