Dear Parents/Carers

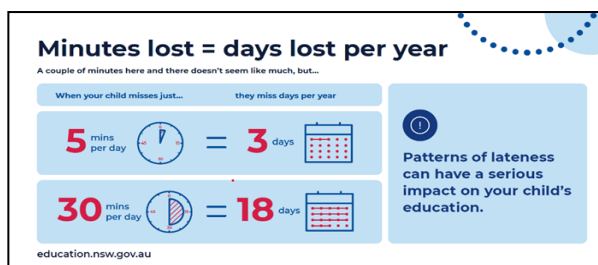

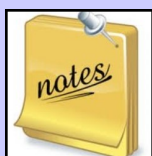
