Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability

Notification for Parents and Carers

All Government and non-Government schools across Australia are required to participate annually in the Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD).

All Australian schools will collect data on their students who are receiving adjustments to meet additional learning and support needs in accordance with their obligations under the *Disability Discrimination Act* 1992 and *Disability Standards for Education* 2005. This data will be provided to the Australian Government to assist in the development of a consistent, national picture of the education needs of students with disability.

The data provided to the Australian Government by the NSW Department of Education is provided in such a way that it cannot be used to identify any individual student or school.

Privacy Protection

The NSW Department of Education follows the requirements of the *Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998* and the *Health Records and Information Privacy Act 2002.* Schools will collect, record, store and use data about individual students in line with these requirements. Data security and protection is a priority and students' personal details will be kept confidential.

Under Clause 52 of the Commonwealth *Australian Education Regulation 2013*, data collected by the NSW Department of Education for the NCCD must be provided to the Australian Government Department of Education and Training. This includes the number of students at each level of education, the number in each category of disability and the number at each level of adjustment. The information is provided to the Commonwealth as a series of number sets that cannot be used to identify any individual student or school.

The Australian Government Department of Education and Training follows the requirements of the Commonwealth *Privacy Act 1988* when handling any data provided by NSW Department of Education in connection with the national data collection. A public information notice has been developed to by the Australian Government to provide students, parents and carers with important privacy information in relation to the data collection. Dear Parents and Carers

DMMSG provides high quality, on-site, general dental care services to children aged 2-17 years

Under the Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS), funded by the Australian Federal Government, our services are at no cost to eligible students. We can provide dental services to eligible children who are covered under the Medicare scheme.

We provide children with essential dental treatment & education using the latest technology in portable dental units.

Our program involves:

- Dental education about oral hygiene and the importance of maintaining great oral health Comprehensive oral examination
- Scale, polish and clean Topical application of Tooth Mousse (decay prevention)
 Fissure Sealant (if required)

To be eligible for CDBS:

- Children must be aged between 2 to 17 years old
- Must be enrolled in Medicare
- · The family must receive Family Tax Benefit Part A

If the child is NOT eligible for CDBS they:

- · Can participate in the dental education
- Can receive the Dental Service at a discounted rate of \$79.00
- · A receipt is given so can claim on private health insurance

You can check eligibility by going to My Gov, then to Medicare and then click on child or calling Medicare on 13 20 11.

The cost for Check-up, clean and tooth mousse is between \$140-\$180 bulk billed to Medicare. If child needs fissure sealant then up to \$185 extra may


