Attend school every day (unless legally excused).

- Arrive at school and class on time.
- Be prepared for every lesson.
- Actively participate in learning.
- Aspire and strive to achieve the highest standards of learning.

If you have any queries or concerns please discuss with your child's classroom teacher. They will then follow up and communicate to you any actions etc. By working together, we can ensure that your children and the students at West have growth everyday and want to attend school each day.

5/6P Classroom

5/6P have been studying changes in states of matter in Science this term. We have specifically been looking at how water changes state from liquid to gas (water vapour) during the process of evaporation. Students modelled this process by designing a scene on a snap lock bag including a river, land, trees, clouds and a sun (most students chose to include a boat in their design as well). Students added water into their bags and we taped these to the window of the classroom to see if the water would evaporate from the bag. The whole process took a little longer than anticipated though due to the ongoing cloudy and wet weather. Hopefully we will see more evaporation over the next week or so! – Miss Parker
